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**IN MEMORIAM**

Warwick L. Morison, M.B., B.S., M.D., F.R.C.P., a former Editor in Chief of Photodermatology, Photoimmunology and Photomedicine (2003-2012), passed away on February 25, 2020, at the age of 78.

Warwick was a Professor of Dermatology at Johns Hopkins, and a leader in photomedicine and photobiology. He was a co-founder of Photomedicine Society (now named Photodermatology Society). He led a photobiology course at the AAD annual meeting for over

10 years. Furthermore, he served for years on the Skin Cancer Foundation, Photobiology Committee and the National Psoriasis Foundation, Medical Advisory Committee. In addition to his dedicated volunteer teaching of the residents at Johns Hopkins, he was committed to education of the clinician about phototherapy. The three editions of his book, "Phototherapy and Photochemotherapy of Skin Disease" have provided a practical, hands-on approach to photomedicine for all who have had the pleasure of reading his comprehensive, user-friendly guide.

He received the 2015 Dermatology Foundation Clark W. Finnerud Award in recognition of his extraordinary time and talent as a part-time teacher and clinician, and was a four times recipient of the "Attending of the Year" award from dermatology residents at Johns Hopkins.

He is survived by his loving wife, Dr. Bronwyn Jones.

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
